Term 3 is typically a busy term with the inclusion of carnivals and events. In 2022 we made a concerted effort to ensure that we kept things calm and in track, as many of you battled illness and Covid fatigue. Student progress during that period was surprisingly strong despite the health challenges and interruptions. So, this term we plan to adopt a similar approach and will be focusing on making the most of every minute in the classroom. The Early Years classroom teams are exploring opportunities for cross setting to implement oral language interventions and target student needs across P-2.

While the Year 3-6 teams will continue to work collaboratively, crossing over for Science and Music and coming together for STEM and Numero. The Year 5-6 students are looking forward to seeing their bus stop artwork installed during the term.





The Faction Cross Country was again a success and it was so pleasing to observe the efforts of all students. One of the behaviour focus that has been reinforced by Mrs

Nelson-Milnes is the notion that "it takes effort to achieve hard things" and for some students cross country is one of those hard things. Through their preparation in physical education lessons students were encouraged to set personal goals around the event, like running the whole way, or finishing the race, or not giving up!

I think the results speak for themselves.

Term 3 is a key time for classroom teachers to analyse Semester 1 student data and plan the remainder of the year to ensure that students are on track to achieve expected outcomes. Student attendance is important all year round. We know that some absences are necessary, but I can not stress enough the impact of irregular attendance on your child's learning outcomes, sense of belonging

and attitude and confidence around learning. Poor attendance habits can form very quickly and research tells us that when poor attendance is perpetuated and supported by families it leads to some very complex attendance issues later in a child's schooling journey. Please discuss any concerns or challenges you are having with attendance in your household.
